Camp Ko-Wa-Kan is an American Camp Association (ACA) accredited camp. All groups staying here must sign a Group Agreement form and comply with KoWaKan policies. Once we have your reservation & deposit, we will proceed to acquire the necessary permits, staff, or other needs for you as requested. We will work with your group leader (as named below) in sharing information and requests related to schedule, permits, program, group covenants, goals, health needs, and more to help you realize a safe and memorable experience!

IMPORTANT: Your initial reservation & permits will be held ONLY after this completed RESERVATION FORM & Non-Refundable Deposit is received. Your deposit should be made payable to Ko-Wa-Kan Adventures. Note: ONLY \$250 of your deposit is transferable if your group cancels on Full Package groups.

Note: For permit purposes alternate leaders are required in case the main leader is not able to pick up the permit. The forest service will only release permits to a group leader or alternate leader named on the permit.

All package rates are “per person – per night”. The total cost is calculated by the # of people X # of nights stayed X the Canoe package chosen / plus Forest Svc. fees.

We will provide an Initial Services Agreement with an estimate cost for your trip based on the numbers you provide above. As you recruit and arrive at your final numbers prior to your trip, we will adjust your Services Agreement, to more accurately represent your final costs. A final adjustment will be made upon your arrival at Camp Ko-Wa-Kan.

A Non-refundable deposit of \$288 for EACH permit group is required to hold your reservation

A final payment is required after your Adjusted Service Agreement is received /prior to your arrival at Ko-Wa-Kan. We will work with you to make any final adjustments needed.

Permit Group Policies & Fees BWCA U.S. Forest Service policy allows a max # of 9 people in each permit group. KWK Guides must be included when calculating your permits and Forest Svc. fees.

- Group Permits – Our reservation fee includes a \$10 fee for each group permit we make with the BWCA - PLUS \$16 for each adult (18 yrs and older) / \$8 for each youth (17 & under).
- We require a minimum of 5 in any “permit group” - not including the KWK guide.
- We require that you provide an adult to serve as a co-leader for each permit group

Ko-Wa-Kan Base Camp Packages / Rentals Includes:

- Full Camp usage – use of nature trails, fire ring, outdoor showers, lake, dock
- KWK Tents with tent site or (platform tent to sleep in, as available)
- Camp equipment such as standard aluminum canoes, paddles, PFDs (For onsite usage or day trips only)
- On-site kitchen areas/equipment to prepare your own food.
- Additional Services & Equipment rentals for overnight trips available (See Rentals on page 4)



You will receive a full orientation to the camp upon your arrival.

Your group will need to Provide for or be Responsible for the following:

- Supervisory support staff for your group.
- Food/beverages plus Clean-up of camp equipment, facilities, and area. .
- No swimming permitted without our staff certified lifeguard present.

Lifeguarding can be arranged and will be charged @ \$17.00 hour; please negotiate time and hours with staff.

Additional staff support available by advanced request and as available:

- Program leadership / nature education / guided day trips into the BWCA / guided hiking trips / campfires / initiative games / teaching of camp skills / worship leadership
- Deliveries & Pick-ups to & from canoe entry points
