KoWaKan (KWK) staff will discern appropriate follow through with Minnesota UMC Camp Director in the event that one of the above agreements is broken. KWK staff reserve the right to have participants leave trips early, at their expense, for failure to abide by this covenant. Any violation of state or federal law will be dealt with by the local law enforcement officers.
